Membership Eligibility:

Candidates will,

- Be at least 18 years of age (proof of age required),
- Have a valid driver's license (license background required)
- Submit application to the department. The candidate will be invited to an interview with the officers of the department. .
- Be voted on by members of BVFD
- Be on probation for 9 months.
- Attend 9hrs. New Recruit training in first 30 days
- Be NC Hazardous Materials Operations level in 12 months

Member Conduct:

- While at the station or representing the BVFD, all members will act in a mature and responsible manner.
- All members are to obey and respect all fire department members.
- All members are to follow instructions given by any Officer of the Dept.
- Absolutely no use of drugs or any other controlled substance.
- All members will obey all traffic laws at all times.

Meetings:

- Business/training meetings will be held once a month. Members cannot have more than two consecutive unexcused absences. To be excused, member needs to contact the Chief or one of the Asst. Chiefs.
- Training meetings are also held once each month.

- Classes through Nash Community & Wilson Tech. are offered at the fire station throughout the year. There is an agenda board in the fire station to keep members posted on upcoming events.

Department Property:

- Each member will be assigned the necessary equipment as quickly as possible. Upon termination of membership, members must return all department property to an officer.
- All equipment, tools, etc. should be treated as if they are your own.
- Members are not allowed to drive fire department owned vehicles until they are trained and checked off by an officer.
- Members will help keep the fire station, equipment, and apparatus clean.
- Physical violence or destruction of property will **not** be tolerated.

Operational Guidelines:

- Members shall **immediately** report any accident or injury to an Officer.
- Members will be trained on equipment before being allowed to use it.
